Hello and greetings from Boulder Hot Springs! There have been a lot of changes and happenings since our last newsletter.

- One major project we completed was changing all of the knob and tube electrical wiring in the east wing of the building to modern wiring. A big thank you to Rudy and Patty Box, Chuck Tesmer and Lynda Endicott and all the others who worked on this project. Thanks also to Anne Wilson Schaefer, one of the primary owners, who set everything up for this project to be completed.
- We did more decorating in the West wing. In the lobby we added some new rugs and bronze sculptures, and in the historic dining room we put up two beautiful antique light fixtures to replace the ones which were stolen a few years ago.
- We also did some major clean up of the 3rd floor of the west wing. There is still no heat, electricity or plumbing in this location and hopefully, some day we will be able to use the rooms in this area.
- On July 2nd, we had a free soak and swim day in honor of the 100 year birthday of the city of Boulder. We had music by Rick Wine, tours, a hot dog and hamburger barbeque, old fashioned pictures, a trivia treasure hunt game and great exhibits from the Heritage Center in Boulder. Thanks to all who attended and helped with the event.
- One major change we made was to switch to having a management team of three people instead of having one general manager. So now Barb Reiter, Jan Zietlow and Kerri Kumasaka are sharing the management responsibilities of Boulder Hot Springs.

In addition, starting on June 1, we began requiring men to wear swimsuits in the men's indoor plunge and steam room areas. This was a suggestion made by our customers and staff. We also began an all day indoor co-ed soaking time on Saturdays. This is in addition to our Sunday 5 – 9 pm and Wednesday 5 – 9 pm indoor co-ed soaking times. Celebrating Women - September 23 - 25, 2011

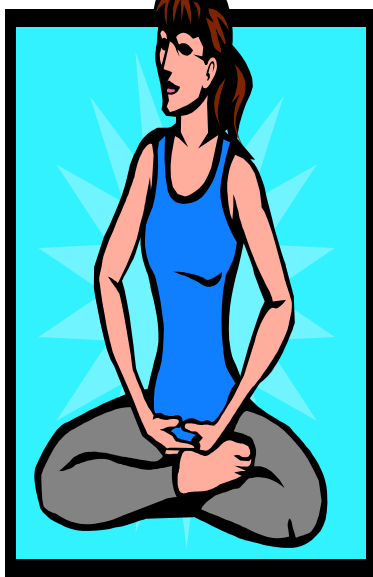
What it's about: Women gathering to celebrate being women, to witness and support other women, to grow community, to flower into our fullest, to rejuvenate, to celebrate, to have fun!

Celebrating Women is a gathering that's happened for 19 years now. Each year we set a different theme, and workshops and large group gatherings specifically or loosely resonate with that theme. This year's theme is "Weaving the Web: creating conscious community."

The gathering is...retreat; workshops; celebration; catharsis; quiet time; rowdy time...whatever each woman wants for herself. We begin Friday afternoon with the first set of workshop sessions, and have three more sessions on Saturday -- for each session, women register for one of three to four possible workshop offerings. Friday evening we also gather as a large group for some singing together, and for a keynote speaker to set the tone for the weekend. Saturday evening is our "high holy hoopla" -- we do some form of group celebration/ ceremony, break out our drums for some free drumming and dancing, and generally have a great time. Sunday includes group meditation time, open sharing in circle time, blessing time, and song and dance to close.

Some women choose to create alone time for themselves, don't go to many workshops, and meet up with others in the hot waters, or on the trails, or just nap. We have all ages of women, all religious affiliations, all classes...we offer scholarships for women for whom money is an obstacle to coming...
